What a gift it is to be a Priest, how blessed I am!! Thank you again to everyone from the bottom of my heart for all your prayers and support over this past year. As I have come to this point in my life, I realized that many of you do not know how I even began this journey. I wanted to take this opportunity to share a small portion of how the Lord radically changed my life from bartender to now priest.

I was blessed to grow up Catholic, receive the Sacraments, altar serve, and grow in my faith as I was a kid. But as I grew, my faith began to dwindle and the sufferings I was going through outweighed my faith in God. Around 18 years old, there was a major break up of my family and I couldn't understand why the Lord would do this. And so, I left. I left the faith, all that I knew to be true and jumped into a world of alcohol, drugs and promiscuity, which lead me to becoming a bartender at a rock n roll western mechanical bull bar. I gave myself fully to that life until one Saturday night, as I was making drinks, I just stopped and looked out into the crowd of 3,000 people and thought to myself, "I have everything the worlds says brings me happiness; money, drugs, alcohol, women, and yet, I am broken, lonely and I flat out hate who I am." It was in that moment that I began to pray to God in 5 years. I said, "Ok Lord, I am back. What do you want with my life." It was in the darkness of that crowded bar that Gods light and grace touched my heart. With His help, I left, began discerning and soon after I entered seminary, where I spent 8 years in formation to become a priest. The Lord is so good, and I have been blessed in my life to see and experience His goodness countless times. I hope that I may be able to share with you all the goodness of our God and Father.

¡ qué regalo es ser sacerdote, cuán bendecido estoy! Gracias de nuevo a todos desde el fondo de mi corazón para todas sus oraciones y apoyo durante el año pasado. Como he llegado a este punto en mi vida, me di cuenta de que muchos de ustedes no saben cómo incluso comencé este viaje. Quería aprovechar esta oportunidad para compartir una pequeña parte de cómo el Señor cambió radicalmente mi vida de barman a ahora sacerdote.

Fui bendecido para crecer católico, recibir los sacramentos, servir al altar, y crecer en mi fe como era un niño. Pero a medida que crecía, mi fe comenzó a menguar y los sufrimientos que atravesaba compensaban mi fe en Dios. Alrededor de los 18 años de edad, hubo una ruptura importante de mi familia y no pude entender por qué el Señor haría esto. Y así, me fui. Dejé la fe, todo lo que sabía que era verdad y salté a un mundo de alcohol, drogas y promiscuidad, o que me lleva a ser cantinero en un bar de rock n roll con un mechanical bull. Me entregué plenamente a esa vida hasta que un sábado por la noche, mientras estaba haciendo bebidas, me paré y miré a la multitud de 3.000 personas y pensé: "tengo todo lo que dicen los mundos me trae felicidad; el dinero, las drogas, el alcohol, las mujeres, y sin embargo, estoy quebrado, solo y odio rotundamente quién soy. Fue en ese momento que comencé a orar a Dios en 5 años. Dije, "bien Señor, he vuelto. ¿Qué quieres de mi vida. Fue en la oscuridad de ese bar lleno de gente que los dioses luz y gracia tocó mi corazón. Con su ayuda, me fui, comencé a discernir y poco después entré en el seminario, donde pasé 8 años en formación para convertirme en sacerdote. El Señor es tan bueno, y he sido bendecido en mi vida para ver y experimentar su bondad incontables veces. Espero que pueda compartir con ustedes toda la bondad de nuestro Dios y padre.

Tengan una semana bendita, y que podamos juntos, seguir hacia una vida de santidad.
