Fr. Scott travels extensively around the world to study different religions. He has written two books, the latest being "Beyond Agreement" which is about how to have a productive interreligious dialogue even when both sides may never come to agreement.

The Miracle of LIFE

The human body is the most complicated and incredible machine in the world. Its bones, muscles, arteries, veins and internal organs are organized with marvelous design. Every part of the body, though each may seem to be so different from another, is made up of the same material: cells.

Cells, each of which is one thousandth of a millimeter, are the structural units that form our body and everything in it. Some of these cells unite to form bones, others to form nerves, the liver, the inner layer of the stomach, the skin or the cornea of the eyeball. Each has the size and shape that exactly meet the requirement of that part of the body.

How and when did cells, which have such varied functions, come into being? All the approximately 100 trillion cells that make up your body today came from the division of one single cell. That single cell which had the same structure as all the cells in your body now, came from the union of your mother's egg cell and your father's sperm cell.

Yes, life begins at conception!

El cuerpo humano es la máquina más complicada e increíble del mundo.

Sus huesos, músculos, arterias, venas y órganos internos se organizan con diseño maravilloso. Cada parte del cuerpo, aunque cada uno puede parecer ser tan diferente de otro, se compone del mismo material: células.

Las células, cada una de las cuales es la milésima parte de un milímetro, son las unidades estructurales que forman nuestro cuerpo y todo lo que contiene. Algunas de estas células se unen para formar huesos, otros para formar los nervios, el hígado, la capa interna del estómago, la piel o la córnea del globo ocular. Cada uno tiene el tamaño y forma que cumplan exactamente con el requisito de parte del cuerpo.

¿Cómo y cuándo estas células, que tienen funciones tan variadas, llegan a existir? Todas las células que son aproximadamente 100 trillones que componen su cuerpo hoy vinieron de la división de solo una célula. Esa célula única que tenía la misma estructura que todas las células de su cuerpo ahora, vino de la unión del óvulo de su madre y el espermatozoide de tu padre.

Sí, la vida comienza en la concepción!
