

## Pope Francis and the Family

As we prepare for the World Meeting of Families and the visit of the Holy Father here this September in Philadelphia, we can get a taste of what we can expect from Pope Francis recent visit to the Philippines

In his address upon his arrival in the Philippines, Pope Francis began by reflecting on the role of St. Joseph, who although seldom mentioned in Scripture, is shown resting not once but twice.

"Joseph's rest revealed God's will to him," the Pope said to the families. "In this moment of rest in the Lord, as we pause from our many daily obligations and activities, God is also speaking to us. He speaks to us in the reading we have just heard, in our prayer and witness, and in the quiet of our hearts. You must make time each day for prayer. But you may say to me: Holy Father, I want to pray, but there is so much work to do! I must care for my children; I have chores in the home; I am too tired even to sleep well. This may be true, but if we do not pray, we will not know the most important thing of all: God's will for us. And for all our activity, our busy-ness, without prayer we will accomplish very little."

The Pope acknowledged the many challenges faced by families, especially those suffering the consequences of natural disasters, economic troubles and separation due to migration. He also noted the threats facing the family in today's society. "The family is also threatened by growing efforts on the part of some to redefine the very institution of marriage, by relativism, by the culture of the ephemeral, by a lack of openness to life," he said. Speaking to the families through his translator, the Pope warned of an "ideological colonization" that tries to destroy families. "It's not born of the dream that we have with God from prayer and the mission that God gives us. It comes [from] outside. And that's why I say it's a colonization," he said.

Encouraging them, the Holy Father told the families to "not lose the freedom to take that mission forward that God has given us....Our world needs good and strong families to overcome these threats! The world needs holy and loving families to protect the beauty and truth of the family in God's plan and to be a support and example for other families. Every threat to the family is a threat to society itself."

The Holy Father went on to call everyone to protect their families and to live as examples of love, for-giveness and care. He also called on them to be "sanctuaries of respect for life." "What a gift this would be to society, if every Christian family lived fully its noble vocation!" he exclaimed. "So rise with Jesus and Mary, and set out on the path the Lord traces for each of you." Concluding his address to the families, Pope Francis urged the families present to be missionary disciples of Jesus and to help the poor and the suffering know that they have not been forgotten by God. "Do not hide your faith, do not hide Jesus, but carry him into the world and offer the witness of your family life!" he exclaimed.

A good message upon which to reflect for all of us as we prepare for the World Meeting of Families in September!

# Diocesan Guidelines for the prevention of the spread of the flu at Mass during flu season

- Parishioners who feel ill should be reminded to stay at home and refrain from attendance at Mass or other church events until they are fully recovered. Illness is a justifiable excuse from the Sunday Mass obligation.
- During the flu season, the faithful should be encouraged to share the Sign of Peace without touching hands or kissing. This may be done with eye-contact, a smile, and a bow of the head while saying the words "May the peace of Christ be with you."
- During the flu season, priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion should be especially reminded of the need to practice good preventative hygiene. Ministers of Holy Communion should be encouraged to wash their hands before Mass begins.
- The faithful should be instructed not to receive from the chalice if they feel ill. That "no one is ever under an obligation to receive from the chalice" and that "anyone who is ill, or suspects he or she is ill, should refrain from receiving from the chalice out of good will and consider receiving the host in the hand rather than by the mouth." (USCCB – Secretariat for Divine Worship)
- During the flu season, greeters and ushers should use verbal greetings only and not shake hands with parishioners.

## **Homemade Wine Tasting and Competition**




