Advent and Time

Even though Advent is coming to a close, it is still upon us. And therefore there still is plenty of time to rededicate ourselves to the Lord and our Catholic faith. No matter where we are in our relationship with the Lord there is always more to go, closer we can be to Him. We must always keep in mind that we can never become complacent with our friendship with Christ.

The Lord must occupy the first place in our lives, and if this is so, all of our other relationships will be more fruitful. We don't limit our other relationships by giving ourselves to the Lord; rather it is through our complete communion with Jesus that our hearts are expanded and we are able to love others more and be loved by others more. Sometimes in our hectic lives often burdened with great concern and worry it is hard for us to see that our priority should still be our relationship with the Lord. But it is true.

Like anything else that is important to us, time more than anything else is the currency we spend to show what and who we value. The more time we spend on something or someone, the more important the person or thing is to us. Perhaps a good meditation we can use during our final Advent preparation for the coming of Jesus at Christmas is to reflect on our use of time. How much time do we spend on things and people? How much time do we spend with and or for the Lord? Is the manner in which we spend the precious resource of our time consistent with the way we describe to others what is important to us? Prayerful and honest consideration of these questions will provide a good insight into our hearts and the people and things we value.

As the saying goes, "show me the money"; in this case it's more "show me the time". The concrete, practical steps we take on how we use our time will be the evidence we show in how we adjust the list of who and what takes priority in our lives.

There is nothing the Lord wants more that to be the center of our lives. There is nothing greater for us than for the Lord to be the center of our lives. As we continue our Advent preparation, may we be open to this awareness so that we can provide a welcoming heart at the arrival of our Lord Jesus.

Reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation


