



Sainte Genevieve

The Feast of the Patroness of our parish will be celebrated on Wednesday, January 3.

Sainte Genevieve was born at Nanterre, near Paris, in 422. A simple shepherdess, she was destined to play an important part in the life of France.

Through her prayers and her influence over her companions, Paris was spared by Attila in 451 and during the siege of that city by Clovia, she succeeded in bringing sufficient provisions to save the inhabitants from starvation. Hence, no doubt, arose the custom of blessing small rolls of bread on her feast day, the 3rd of January. She seems to extend her protection particularly to Christian mothers and to the unemployed workmen. Sainte Genevieve died in 512, after having been throughout her life the visible comforter of all infirmities and miseries.

Prayer to Sainte Genevieve

O great Sainte Genevieve, I place myself under your powerful protection. Bless me, bless my family, my friends, and all those for whom I should pray. Bless the house in which we dwell. Be our safeguard against the dangers which threaten us. Protect Christian mothers and obtain for their children the grace of Baptism. Provide for us work together with the necessities of life. Obtain for us especially the grace to live and die in God's friendship and to have the happiness of meeting in heaven, there to praise forever the great God who created us and redeemed us on the Cross. Amen

Reflection

In his Apostolic Exhortation, Familiaris Consortio, Blessed John Paul II called attention to the need for pastoral care of families that bear the cross of difficult family situations. "Loneliness and other difficulties are often the lot of separated spouses, especially when they are the innocent parties." He continued by explaining that "the ecclesial community must support such people more than ever...and it must help them to cultivate the need to forgive which is inherent in Christian love..." Troubled or broken marriages are particularly difficult for the children, who naturally identify their existence with the love between their mother and father. When that love no longer appears to exist, a deep rooted loss of self may begin to be felt. Although it may be very difficult, with the help of God's grace, it is always possible to heal from the wounds of division. As Blessed John Paul II emphasized, "No one is without a family in this world: the Church is a home and family for everyone, especially those who 'labor and are heavy laden (no. 85)."

The application deadline for Beyond Sunday, SOAR!, Catholic Families Tuition Assistance (CFTA), and the Parish Employees Endowment Fund (PEEF) is February 28th, 2018. Any family who would like to be considered for these programs, even if you are applying for requalification, must apply between January 29th and February 28th, 2018.

Up to 60 new elementary school awards and 35 new high school awards will be available in Beyond Sunday. Siblinas attending the same school are not eligible in this program.

St. Louis City residents applying for elementary schools in the City should also apply as early as possible to be considered for Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow.




