LITURGY CORNER

Today we celebrate the Third Sunday of Easter. We continue to hear in the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles (written by Saint Luke) how the early church grew. We see the beginnings of our current liturgies—Baptism, Confirmation, and Reconciliation—as well as Holy Mass. As the Church grew the need for more space and for a more structured and similar way of celebrating became more important. There is a Eucharistic Prayer very similar to the ones we currently use that dates back to the First Century. Over the years, with Vatican I and especially with Vatican II, liturgy-the way we worship-has not been changed as much as made more “user friendly”. With the Third Roman Missal, many of the prayers and responses have gone back to a more true translation.



Many converts to Catholicism try to use Holy Scripture to put down the Roman Catholic Church, but find as they sit in Holy Mass that the way we worship is very much Scriptural. We can see this in Acts and even more so in Revelation. Our Faith has, in addition to Holy Scripture, Sacred Tradition. One can go back to the Early Church Fathers and trace from there the Tradition of the Church still used today. Look at the Apostle’s Creed and the Nicene Creed as just a minute example. As we follow the Acts of the Apostles through the Easter Season and learn more about Jesus in the Gospels, we can more appreciate the beauty of Jesus’ Church.


