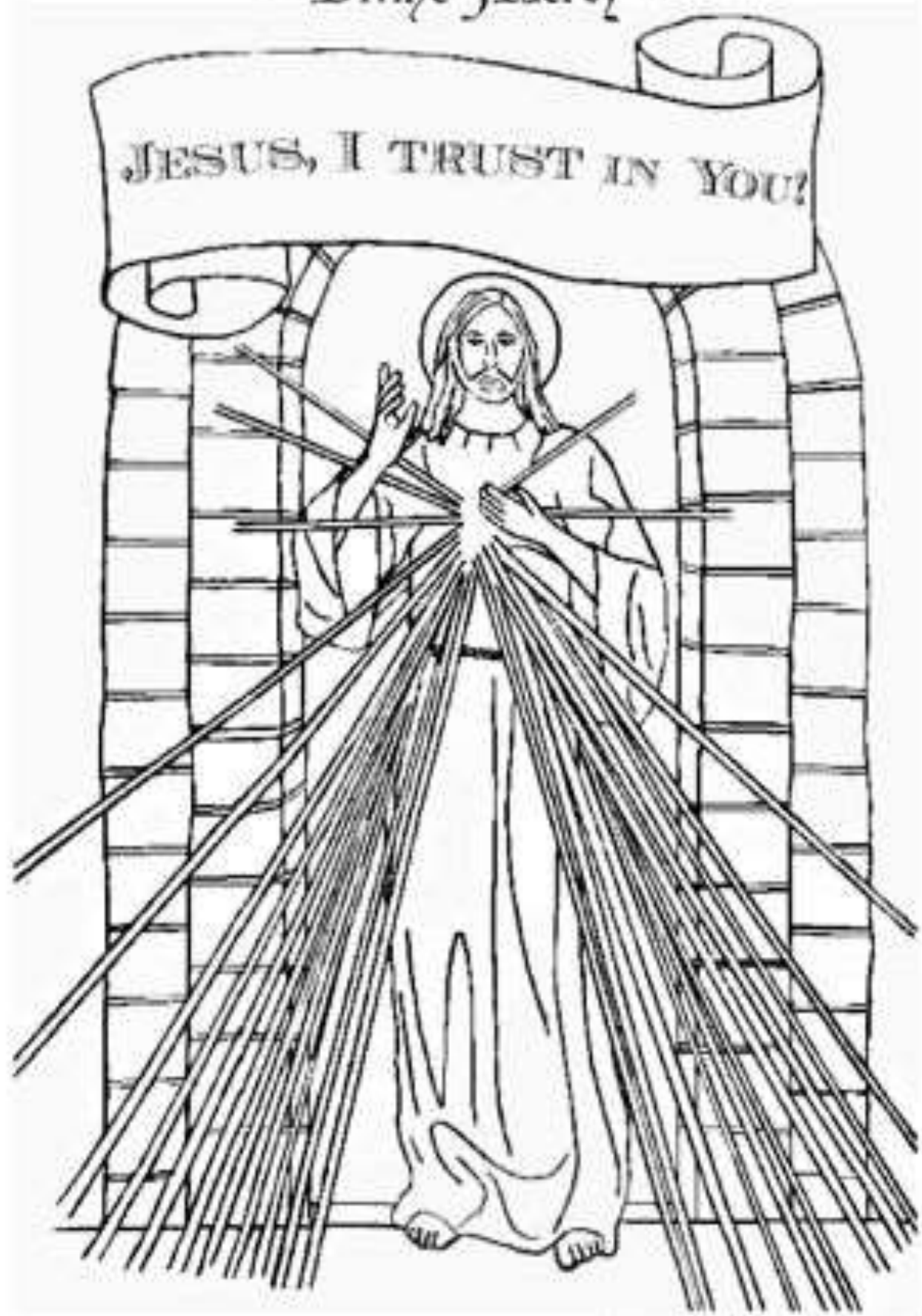
- The retreat for students preparing for 1st Holy Communion is this Saturday, April 14th, from 9-noon. Students and one parent must be in attendance.

LITURGY CORNER

Today is the Second Sunday of Easter, or Divine Mercy Sunday. The Octave of Easter ends today but we continue in the Easter Season until Pentecost Sunday. Saint Pope John Paul designated this Sunday as the Divine Mercy. Our Novena to the Divine Mercy ended on Saturday where we spent 9 days praying with Saint Faustina Kowalska who was visited by Jesus in the 1930's. Saint Faustina, Sister Maria Faustina of the Most Blessed Sacrament, a member of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Warsaw, Poland, kept a diary of the many visits Jesus made to her and of what he said. He requested that an image of himself as he had appeared to her, with the words, "Jesus, I trust in you", be made and venerated. He also gave her the Divine Mercy chaplet and requested that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be established. We are reminded of God's mercy through the visits of Jesus to Saint Faustina, but we also see the great mercy of God in the Scriptures. In the Collect, the opening prayer of today's Mass, we hear, "God of everlasting mercy..." Psalm 118, the Responsorial Psalm, says, "His mercy endures forever". In today's Gospel from Saint John, Thomas sees firsthand the mercy of God. We are called in the Liturgy to go forth, to proclaim the Gospel. We are called not only to believe in God's mercy but to be merciful. What we profess and Who we receive in Holy Mass, we are called to share with the world. "Doing good without expecting anything in return. This is what the Father did with us and we must do the same. Do good and carry on!" (Pope Francis) Tomorrow is the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. Our Blessed Mother said her "yes". In light of God's unending mercy, can we do no less. *Have a good week in the Risen Lord...Gay Snell*
