LITURGY CORNER

RCIA or Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, is a series of liturgical rites promulgated by the Congregation for Divine Worship. It was brought back in its current form by the Second Vatican Council and then revised by the Congregation for Divine Worship in 1972 and again in 1986 following the norms set in 1972. In 1988 the current book containing the rites now used was published by the National Conference of Catholic Bishops. (Most of these rites are also contained within the Roman Missal.) RCIA is a set of liturgical rites encompassed within a program that contains prayer, learning about the Catholic Church, and preparation for sacraments. The process includes preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. “The rite of Christian initiation presented here is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. By God’s help they will be strengthened spiritually during their preparation and at the proper time will receive the sacraments fruitfully.” (*RCIA Study Edition, Introduction*) Those adults who have never been baptized, baptized into another Christian faith, or baptized Catholic but not catechized or raised in the Church are welcome to participate in the RCIA process. The series of rites and the catechesis offered each week, prepares them for Baptism and/or Confirmation and to receive their First Holy Communion. The Rite of Christian Initiation normally takes place at the Easter Vigil. The parish community participates in these rites, as they take place during Holy Mass, and prays for the individuals who are preparing for the Easter Sacraments.

If you are interested in the RCIA process or know someone who is, please call the Religious Education Office. There will be an informational night on Thursday, August 23, at 7:00 pm in the San Clemente parish hall.
