~ Liturgy Corner ~

Devotions take many forms and are begun by many people—most often after a visit by or conversation with Jesus, his Blessed Mother, or a saint—to that person. The devotion of attending Mass and devoting the first Friday of nine consecutive months to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, for example, is based on the private revelations of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690). She was a French religious of the Visitation Order and instigated the spreading of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus after Our Lord appeared to her. He told her of his desire to be loved by all and to encourage everyone to seek sanctification and salvation. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has five (5) main elements: 1. Adoration. Jesus proposed his Sacred Heart for worship as the source of love, mercy, grace, sanctification, and salvation for all, and asked that its image be honored. 2. Belief in the merciful love of that heart for all. 3. A generous return of love for Jesus who indicated his wish for all to love him. 4. Reparation. Jesus asked his faithful to love him more and more to make up for those who do not love him. 5. Special love and reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. In recent years, (for nearly 10 years before her death in 1923) the doctrine of mercy of the Sacred Heart has been confirmed through a series of private revelations to a humble Spanish lay sister of the Religious of the Sacred Heart, Sister Josefa Menendez. In 1956, Pope Pius XII recommended the practice of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to all the faithful. One way to carry on this devotion is attendance at Holy Mass nine consecutive First Fridays. Another is enthronement of the image of the Sacred Heart in one's home.
