LITURGY CORNER

“Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the ‘sacraments of Christian initiation,’” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 1285). “...the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For ‘by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed’”. (CCC, 1285) In Confirmation we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit—completing our baptism—, thus strengthening us to fight off the temptations of Satan. We also follow the example set by Jesus when he was baptized and confirmed by John through the power of the Holy Spirit. And we join those who received the Holy Spirit at the first Pentecost. In the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, those to be confirmed must be of high school age. However, not all young adults receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. As adults who are not yet confirmed, it is time to say “yes” to your baptismal promises and to complete your initiation. As with all liturgies, the rite of Confirmation is set by the Church. It also takes place within Holy Mass.

If you are not yet confirmed, 18 or older, and desire to learn more, come to an informational meeting on Thursday, August 23, 2018, at 7:00 pm in the San Clemente parish hall.
