## LITURGY CORNER


Friday we celebrated the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. "God chose Mary, the Immaculate Conception, to be our 'model of holiness' (Preface). The Yes of Mother Mary at the Annunciation, the culmination of the Immaculate Conception, undoes the disobedience of Eden, Adam and Eve, and makes paradise a possibility once again for us. (Magnificat, December 2017) The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Marian dogma. It teaches that Mary, in view of her calling to be the Mother of Jesus, was thus preserved from the first moment of her conception from original sin and was filled with grace from the very beginning of her life. The present form of this feast dates from 1854 with Pope Pius IX. Between February 11 and July 16, 1858, fourteen-year -old Bernadette Soubirous reported seeing 18 visions of a woman dressed in white in a grotto near Lourdes, France. The woman identified herself as the Immaculate Conception. On Tuesday, December 12, we celebrate another Marian feast. Our Lady of Guadalupe. On the morning of December 9, 1531 our Lady appeared to Juan Diego as he hurried to Mass near Mexico City. She told him that she was the "ever - Virgin Mary, Mother of the true God". Our Lady of Guadalupe was declared to be the patroness of all the Americas by Pope Pius XII. In 1999 Pope John Paul II declared her to also be the Patroness of the Unborn. Gav Snell
