**LITURGY CORNER**



Christmas is such an important time in our liturgical year and in our lives that we celebrate for 8 days, the Octave of Christmas. Today we celebrate The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. We look to them for inspiration in our own families and the importance of families

in our world. The devotional background of this feast was strong in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, particularly in France and Spain. In the 18<sup>th</sup> century, in prayers composed for a special Mass, Blessed Francois Laval, the first Canadian bishop, likened the Christian family to the Holy Family. Pope Leo XIII consecrated families to the Holy Family.



January 1, tomorrow, is the last day of the Octave of Christmas, and we fittingly celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. Devotion to Mother Mary has been constant and profound since apostolic times. Since the earliest days of the Church, she alone has been given a veneration and honor second only to God. She is rightly called the Mother of God, “full of grace,” “Mother of the Church,” and in prayer and devotion “Our Lady,” the “Blessed Virgin Mary,” and the “New Eve.” This is one of the many liturgical Marian feasts. The Hail Mary is among the most basic prayer; the Rosary among the most often said. We thank God for Our Blessed Mother’s “yes” at the Annunciation, for the birth of her Son, Jesus, at Christmas, and honor her on January 1 as the Holy Mother of God. *Gay Snell*
