### LITURGY CORNER

Today is the 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. This season of the liturgical year is the last and culminates with the solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe on November 25. It is the longest season of the year. From the *seder* meal, that we looked at last week, Jesus went out to give up his body and shed his blood in the Crucifixion. "Yet his sense of urgency, his earnest desire, remained. For, on the day he rose from the dead, he wasted no time before repeating the action of the Last Supper. Encountering two disciples on the road to Emmaus, he prevented them from recognizing him. Only when they sat at table were their eyes opened, and they knew him "in the breaking of the bread" (Luke 24:35)." (The Mass of the Early Christians) From the Last Supper, and then from the Road to Emmaus, the Eucharist and the Passover were inseparable to the first Christians. And what Jesus began continues each and every day. (1Cor 5:7-8) The first Christians now saw that all the worship of ancient Israel had led them and all God's people to this moment. Now we see the fulfillment of God's covenants with a new and final covenant in Jesus' blood. Christian worship continues the worship of Israel. Many prayers and songs of the synagogue, Temple, and the Jewish home remain in the Christian liturgy. For example, the Sanctus, or "Holy, holy, holy," is based on Isaiah 6:3. Sanctus also appears in the Book of Revelation (4:8) and in the works of St. Clement of Rome, Tertullian in North Africa, and Origen in Egypt. The Alleluia and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" have also found their way into our liturgy. More next week... Gay Snell


