## ~ Liturgy Corner ~

Today is the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Entrance Antiphon: *All peoples, clap your hands. Cry to God with shouts of Joy!* The Responsorial Psalm: *For ever I will sing the goodness of the Lord.* How do we give back to God for his goodness? Over the past few weeks we have been looking at the various liturgical ministries. In addition, there are other ministries within the parish that are not liturgical. Today, however, we continue looking at liturgical ministries, those within Holy Mass, with the Ministry of Altar Server. To be an Altar Server, one must have received his/her First Holy Communion and attend a training. The Altar Server performs many duties during Holy Mass (and thus should be in the state of grace and able to receive Holy Communion)—carrying the cross in procession, handling of the Roman Missal, ringing of the bells, assisting with washing of the celebrant's hands, receiving the gifts, setting out and removing the vessels, and the incense, to name a few. It is a lot to remember but with training and performing their ministry, the servers are able to remember and perform these tasks well. The older, in age as well as longevity, servers help the younger/newer servers. In addition to serving at Sunday Mass, they often attend and serve at daily Mass, assist with Benediction and with Stations of the Cross. It is a blessing to have incense at one Sunday Mass every week. The servers who handle the incense at this Mass are specially trained in how to set up, assist the priest and deacon, and what to do with the hot coals after Mass. Once a young person is trained, he/she is scheduled to serve. If you are interested in becoming an Altar Server, call the parish office and watch the bulletin for the next training. If you are currently a server, thank you for answering the call and for your ministry to the Church. *Gay Snell*
