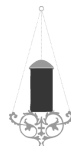

Liturgy Corner
July 9, 2017

Liturgical Ministries we have discussed to date are Lector, Extra-ordinary Minister of Holy Communion, and Altar Server. Other ministries within Holy Mass are Usher/Greeter, and Choir member. Ushers and Greeters are the first people we encounter as we come into the church. They greet us and welcome us into not only our worship space but the liturgy itself. They also are available should anyone need assistance or if there is an emergency during Mass. Each Mass has a head usher who assures there are enough ushers to assist and to take up the collection, get the collection placed in the Sanctuary, and transferred into a secure bag after Mass. He/she also selects those who will bring up the gifts at each Mass. Usher/Greeters, because they do not minister at the Altar, can be anyone willing to assist. The choir leads the assembly in song, whether it be the parts of Holy Mass or the processional songs. Anyone with the desire, and some musical knowledge, is welcome to be a choir member. Doing so, however, means attending practices and Holy Mass. One last ministry within any liturgy is the Assembly—those of us who sit in the pews at any given Mass. The role of the lay person in the pew is to actively and consciously participate. It is not enough to just be in attendance—we must stand, kneel, sit, pray, respond, sing. Any liturgical ministry requires some time and dedication but is a great way to be more a part of Holy Mass and give back to God.

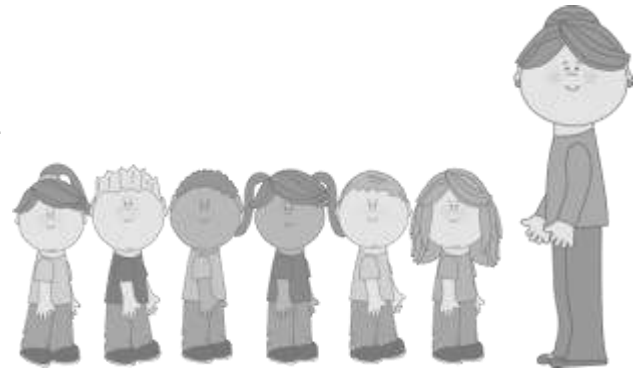

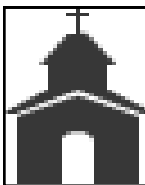
