~ Liturgy Corner ~

This week let's look at the ministry of the Lector. According to *the General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, #59, "The function of proclaiming the readings is by tradition not presidential but ministerial. Therefore the readings are to be read by a reader, but the Gospel by the Deacon or, in his absence, by another Priest. If, however, a Deacon or another Priest is not present, the Priest Celebrant himself should read the Gospel, and moreover, if no other suitable reader is present, the Priest Celebrant should also proclaim the other readings as well." Thus, the proclamation of the First and Second Readings is primarily the duty and privilege of the Lector and so a Lector or Lectors should be present at every Mass. "The Word of the Lord." These five words give us the essence of the ministry of the Lector. After the Reading is proclaimed the Lector looks up at the assembly and says, "The Word of the Lord." We know that something wonderful has happened—the mystery of God's interaction with us has been recalled, revived, and renewed. We have once again heard God reveal His divine intention to love, redeem, and reclaim us. We answer, "Thanks be to God." Thanks, indeed, to the God who summons us in love every time the Word is proclaimed in our midst. All Christians are, by definition, proclaimers of the good news. The Second Vatican Council recognized the ministry of Lector, among the other liturgical ministries, as being a lay ministry and stressed the importance of training and installation of said ministers. If you think you are called to this important ministry, call the parish office. Then watch the bulletin for the next Lector training session.

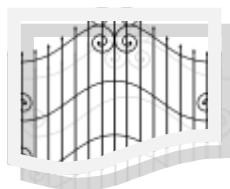

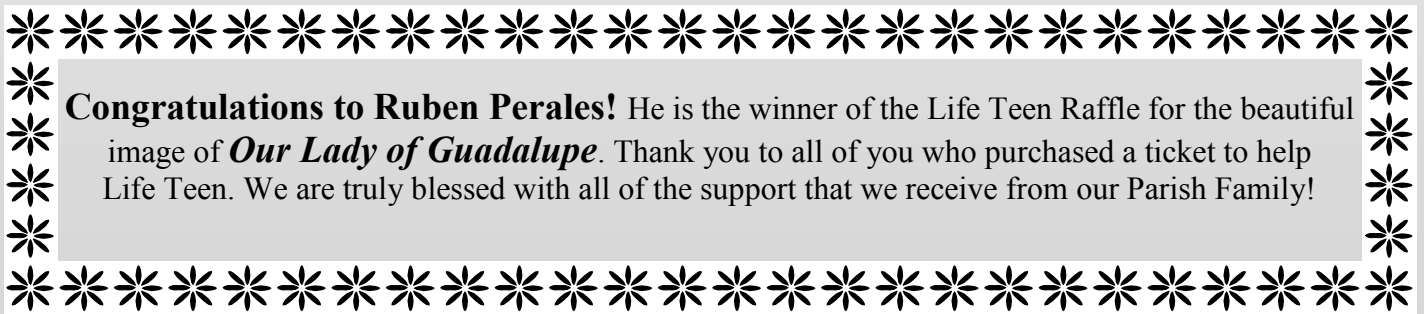

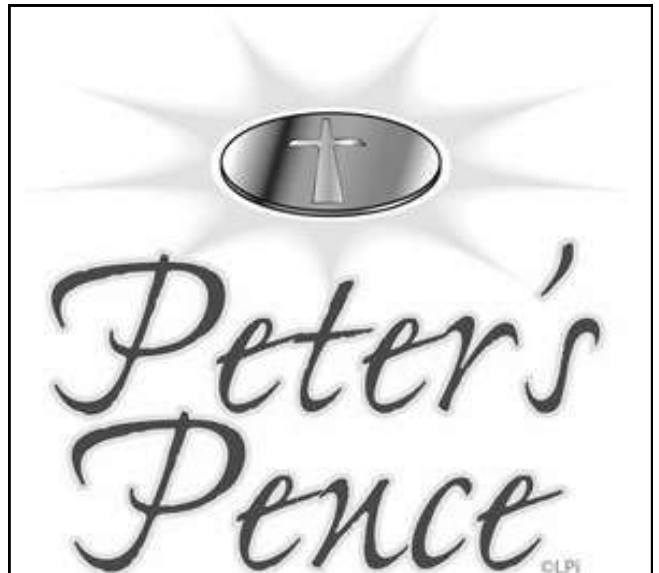
