LITURGY CORNER

There are other Lenten devotions, besides the Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings, available at San Clemente. One is daily Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 12:00 to 1:00 pm, Monday through Thursday. It is a wonderful way to spend lunch time, even if only one day a week. Also, there is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every Friday after Morning Mass until 5:45 pm. What a great way to spend some time with Our Lord. Making time during these weeks for Confession before Easter is so important, and San Clemente is blessed to have Confessions available more than one or two hours on Saturday afternoons. A most important devotion is the parish Lenten Mission, March 19, 20, 21. Evenings may entail sports, dinner, homework, and just catching up on household chores. For these 3 evenings, include Mass and the Mission talks in your schedule. (The schedule is in the bulletin.) Liturgical devotions include adding Daily Mass to your already busy schedule. The blessings from this are immeasurable. Lent is a time for reflection and penance. It is the Church's primary penitential season in the liturgical year. COME TO THE LIGHT

Nicodemus came to Jesus at night, in the darkness. He was fearful and his faith was weak. As we travel through this Lenten season, we too are invited to live in the light, to deepen our faith, and to open ourselves to God’s only Son, Jesus, sent into the world for our salvation. —Angeline Hubert

What fears keep me remaining in the darkness and not seeking the light of Christ?

Today is called *Laetare* Sunday, from the Latin word for *rejoice*, which is the first word of the Entrance Aniphon of the Mass, “Rejoice Jerusalem” (Isaiah 66:10). It reminds us that the rigors of Lent are now over half-completed and encourages our anticipation for Easter.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is scheduled for the noon hour each Monday through Thursday during Lent.

We will also have *Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament* every Friday during Lent following the 7:00 a.m. Mass.

Benediction will take place at 5:45 p.m., Mass at 6:00 p.m., followed by Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m.

Please sign up for Adoration for at least one hour each Friday. It is important that there are enough adorers and that Our Lord is *never* left alone. It is also important that no one is left by themselves during their Holy Hour.

Please think and pray about what your Lenten devotions will include this season.
