LITURGY CORNER

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord and begin our Holy Week journey. Thursday we begin the Triduum. "The Easter Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of Christ is ... the culmination of the entire liturgical year. What Sunday is to the week, the Solemnity of Easter is to the liturgical year" (General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar #18). The Triduum is a single three-day-long liturgical event. It begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday and ends with Vespers on Easter Sunday evening. We are invited to begin these three days on Thursday commemorating the Last Supper where Jesus washed the feet of the Apostles and instituted the Holy Eucharist. At this Eucharistic service enough Hosts are consecrated to distribute Holy Communion on both Thursday and Friday. Because Friday is the Celebration of the Lord's Passion and Death, there is no consecration at this service. It begins in silence and ends in silence. We hear in the Gospel of John the Passion of Our Lord. We receive him, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. We adore the Cross upon which he died for us. It is meant to be a quiet, solemn time. At the Easter Vigil the quiet and solemnness is replaced with the anticipation of the Resurrection. All the symbols for Jesus, the Light of the World, are brand-new, lighted, and brought into the church. We hear from Genesis, Exodus, Isaiah, Baruch, Ezekiel, Saint Paul, Saint Luke, the Psalms. The church goes from darkness to light with the entrance of the Paschal Candle. We sing the Alleluia and the Gloria. The bells are rung. We see new life in Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion. On Easter Sunday we celebrate with joy--The Lord Has Risen-Alleluia! Gay Snell
