LITURGY CORNER

Today is Pentecost Sunday and the end of the Easter Season. After the Sunday evening Mass the Paschal Candle will be processed back to the Baptismal Font where it will remain, except for funerals, until the next Easter Vigil. “By the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost, Christ’s Paschal Mystery was brought to its completion” (Saint Cyril of Alexandria). In the Entrance Antiphon...*The love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Spirit of God dwelling within us, alleluia.* It is at Pentecost that the Apostles received the Holy Spirit... their Confirmation...and then went out into the world to spread the Good News of Jesus. According to Saint Luke in Acts of the Apostles, “They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers” (Acts 2:42). This becomes the beginnings of Holy Mass which would continue in every generation afterward. In the breaking of bread and in the prayers we relive not only the Last Supper, but the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Church is sustained by the Eucharist. Some 20 years after Pentecost, Saint Paul gave the Church of Corinth detailed instructions about how to conduct the Mass and how to understand it. (See 1 Corinthians 10-11) From the next generation (60-100), the Church of Antioch in Syria left us the *Didache*, a manual that contains liturgical prayers that are still in use today. As the century turned, Pope Saint Clement quoted from the Roman liturgy – “Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might!” – in his own letter to the Corinthians. (The Mass of the Early Christians)
