## ~ Liturgy Corner ~

“Jesus is really and truly present...” “Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity...” “...This is My Body...This is My Blood...” Liturgy is the way we worship, but it is not only about the music, the Scripture, or the prayers. Liturgy is about Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Whether we are attending Holy Mass, celebrating the Sacraments, at a Liturgy of the Word service, or sitting in the church or chapel praying, we are in the presence of Jesus. Saint John says in his Gospel, “So Jesus said to them, ‘Amen, amen, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.’” (John 6:32-33) “Jesus said to them, ‘I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst.’” (John 6:35) Jesus is truly present in our churches in the form of the Blessed Sacrament. When we leave for a non-Catholic parish, or marry outside of the Church, or do not attend Holy Mass, we have walked away from Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. We have the fullness of the Faith. In thinking about the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparitions at Fatima, in honoring our Mothers on Mother's Day, in honoring our Blessed Mother, there is a sadness in how, by walking away from the Blessed Sacrament, we not only dishonor our Blessed Mother who wants us to follow her Son, we also dishonor our earthly mothers and fathers. They are our first teachers. They are the ones who have dragged us-sometimes kicking and screaming-to Mass. They are the ones who show us how to pray and the importance of attending Mass. We honor them by following their example and by taking ownership of our own salvation. Thanks to all Mothers and Fathers for their faithfulness. *Gay Snell*
