## ~ Liturgy Corner ~

Looking again at posture, we sit for the First and Second Readings and the Responsorial Psalm. At the *Alleluia* we stand and prepare for the Proclamation of the Gospel (which is proclaimed by the Deacon, or Priest when there is no deacon). Before the deacon proclaims the Gospel, however, he bows to the celebrant and says, *Your blessing, Father.* To which the celebrant replies, *May the Lord be in your heart.* Before proclaiming the Gospel, the Deacon signs the Book with his thumb and then himself on his forehead, mouth, and breast. We make this threefold sign with him. So what does this mean? As we sign our forehead, mouth and breast we are saying, “May the Word of the Lord live in our minds and on our lips and in our hearts.” In this Easter Season, having brought new life into the Church at the Easter Vigil and renewing our own Baptismal promises, I share this with you...

*We say it with a cross. Not a large gesture, but a small one, like the anointing we received when baptized into Christ Jesus; binding our lives to his life, our crosses to his cross, our words to his words. Three small gestures; not dramatic, not expansive; but like most of our lives—the daily efforts, the little ways by which we strive to be faithful to the proclamation of the Word in our speaking and loving and serving. We say it with a cross, the sign of our commissioning. A reminder that the Lord’s cross, borne in pain but forever now the emblem of life and love triumphant, is engraved upon us and we bear it for the world. -Janet Schlichting, OP*
