LITURGY CORNER

San Clemente Church is named for Saint Clement I who was the 4th pope. He was martyred about the year 100. He wrote a famous epistle to the Corinthians to strengthen and encourage peace and unity among them. His feast day is November 23. San Clemente Church will honor our patron with a fiesta Mass and Eucharistic procession on Saturday, November 17 at 8:00 am followed by 2 days of fun and celebration. Even though this will not be the actual feast day, the Readings and prayers for November 23 can and will be used. The mayordomos are working hard to plan and put together a great fiesta weekend. This is our parish, our feast day, and our family; we should all participate and support our parish and each other. Ever wonder where the term "mayordomo" comes from? In the southwest, it is a person in charge of a group or project, such as, a hacienda, ranch, or estate; an overseer of an irrigation system... It also comes from Spain as the one who preserved the records or supervised the household. In a parish they are called upon to assist the parish as needed, especially with major feast days such as Easter, Christmas, or the parish feast day.
