LITURGY CORNER

Friday, October 13, was the 100th anniversary of the final apparition of Our Lady to three children in Fatima, Portugal. Our Lady of Fatima is the Marian title and image based on the six apparitions between May 13 and October 13, 1917. During her final visit to Lucia dos Santos and her cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto, “the Lady” revealed she was Our Lady of the Rosary. The children reported that Mother Mary asked for frequent praying of the Rosary, penance, increased devotion to her Immaculate Heart, prayers for the conversion of Russia, and the building of a church in her honor. She promised a miracle—the appearance of the sun “spinning”—which was witnessed by 50 thousand people. Francisco died in 1919 and Jacinta died in 1920, during a flu epidemic. Lucia became a Sister of Saint Dorothy and then a Carmelite nun. She received a 7th apparition in 1921. Pope Pius XI authorized devotion to Our Lady of Fatima in 1930. The Marian shrine in Fatima is among the most famous in the world. Fatima became especially prominent in the papacy of Saint John Paul II who became a friend of Lucia’s. The 1981 attempt on his life took place on May 13, the anniversary of the first apparition. He attributed his survival to a direct intervention of Our Lady of Fatima. In 2000, he beatified Francisco and Jacinta. Lucia died February 13, 2005 at the age of 97.
