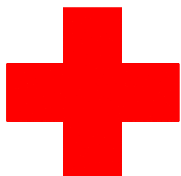
**NEWS FROM THE PASTORAL COUNCIL

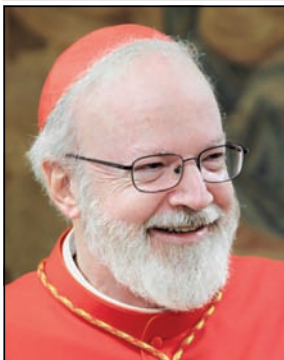

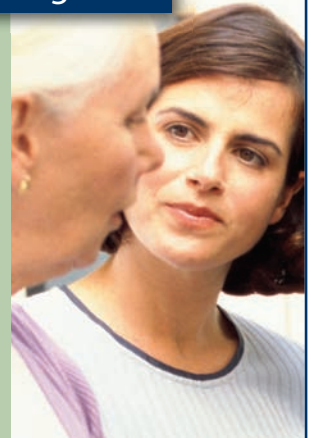
