**Celebrating Children  
At Our Parishes**

To the parents of our young children, may we suggest...

- Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house.
- Sit toward the front where it is easier to see and hear.
- Quietly explain the parts of the Mass.
- Sing the hymns; pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you and other adults.
- If you need to leave Mass with your child, please feel free to do so but please come back!
- Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to church, to God, and to Jesus. Let them know that they are at home in this liturgical gathering.
- To the members of the parish...A smile and word of encouragement is always welcome to parents with small, active children.
