



Staff and Pastoral Plan Writing Team News

Members of our staff and Pastoral Plan Writing Team traveled to Saint Dorothy Parish in Wilmington on Tuesday, June 9, to join their counterparts from the Wilmington Collaborative and the North Andover Collaborative for additional training related to Disciples in Mission, the pastoral planning process for the Archdiocese of Boston.

Staff members spent the afternoon continuing to work with DISC, a personal assessment tool used to improve work productivity, teamwork and communication. They also began to discern personal values - enduring beliefs that guide behaviors, decisions, and actions.

Deacon Pat from the Catholic Leadership Institute led Pastoral Plan Writing Team members through a series of exercises to help them do preliminary work on collaborative purpose statement, values, and vision statement. They also did some initial work on identifying three collaborative priorities, one of which must be the promotion of a culture of vocations to the diocesan priesthood. All of this is foundational work for the writing of the collaborative pastoral plan, a first draft of which is due to Cardinal Sean in December 2015.

Staff members and Pastoral Plan Writing Team members will continue to work of these things through the summer in preparation for the next training day, which takes place on September 9 at Saint Michael Parish in North Andover.

That we may show respect and love to our fathers, who have given us life and love, and to all father- figures.


That the faith of fathers who have lost a child through death may give them hope.
