I would sleep little, but I would dream more, because I know that for every minute we close our eyes, we waste 60 seconds of light.


I would walk while others stop; I would stay awake while others sleep.

never arrives. I am sure you will be sorry you wasted the opportunity today to give a smile, a hug, a kiss, and that you were too busy to grant them their last wish.

Keep your loved ones near you; tell them in their ears and to their faces how much you need them and love them. Love them and treat them well; take your time to tell them "I am sorry," "forgive me," "please," "thank you," and all those loving words you know.

Nobody will know you for your secret thoughts. Ask the Lord for wisdom and strength to express them.

Show your friends and loved ones how important they are to you.

Send this letter to those you love. If you don't do it today... tomorrow will be like yesterday, and if you never do it, it doesn't matter either, the moment to do it is now.

## Ordo for the Week

April 23 2nd Sunday of Easter

April 24 St. George, Martyr & Patron of England

Although St. George did not kill or even fight a dragon, he did confront and rebuke the Roman emperor Diocletian, of who Imperial Guard George was a member, for issuing an edict of persecution against the Christians. For being a Christian, Diocletian had him beheaded.

## April 25 St. Mark, Evangelist

St. Mark was associated with St. Paul and St. Barnabas (who was Mark's cousin) on their missionary journey through the island of Cyprus. Later he accompanied St. Barnabas alone. We know also that he was in Rome with St. Peter and St. Paul. Tradition ascribes to him the founding of the Church in Alexandria, Egypt. St. Mark wrote his Gospel, probably in Rome sometime before the year 60 A.D.; he wrote it in Greek for the Gentile converts to Christianity.

## April 29 St. Catherine of Siena

Her mystical experiences started when she was 6. She became a Dominican when she was 16, and her visions continued. In 1375, Our Lord gave her the Stigmata. She persuaded the Pope to return to Rome from Avignon. In 1377, when she died at age 33, she was trying to heal the Great Western Schism. Her letters, and a treatise called "a dialogue" are considered among the most brilliant writings in the history of the Catholic Church.




## **PSR Catechists Needed**
