scratching and whining, and as he opened the door, a dog sprang into the room and leaped on him with an eager show of gladness. Turning to the patient, the doctor said, "Did you notice my dog? He's never been in this room before. He didn't know what was inside. He knew nothing except that his master was here, and when the door opened, he sprang in without fear. I know little of what is on the other side of death, but I do know one thing... I know my Master is there and that is enough." (from an email sent to me)

The Catholic Faith does not give all of the answers to life after death questions, and as a matter of a fact our Lord did not reveal much about it, other than there is a place called Heaven, where God dwells, and "He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, [for] the old order has passed away. (Rev 4:21)"; "if we persevere we shall also reign with Him (2 Tim 2:12)." and "From now on the crown of righteousness awaits me, which the Lord, the just judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me, but to all who have longed for his appearance. (2 Tim 4:8)" The Catholic Faith does not give us a total and complete knowledge of God, but it does give us enough knowledge about God that Jesus Christ revealed to appeal to our intellect and know that there is One God, Who made us, Who Loves us and wants us to be with Him forever.

This One God is a unity of Three Divine Persons of Infinite Love, and this Infinite Love that God has for each one of us is mysterious and amazing. As All-Powerful God, He can not suffer or die; but because His Infinite Love for each of us knows no boundaries God became a weak human being to suffer and die. He sacrificed Himself so we will come to know how much He Loves us and to restore His Life with us and to save us into Heaven through a personal relationship of love with God. The degree that you love another, is to the degree that you are willing to sacrifice of yourself for that person or persons.

The Catholic Faith teaches us about Jesus' Sacrificial Love to enable us to know God's Infinite Love, so that we might love Him in return. Faith is knowledge of God that can lead us to trust in God's Love in every situation and circumstance that we find ourselves, whether the events are tragic or joy-filled. God is with us, and is always eager to reveal Himself to those who believe by a trusting Faith, Hope and Love in God. When we practice these three evangelical virtues in our lives, we put to use The Divine Powers that give us spiritual eyes to see what can not be seen and spiritual ears to hear what can not be heard.

Jn 14:26 "The Advocate, the holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name--he will teach you everything and remind you of all that [I] [*Jesus*] told you."

Jn 15:26 "When the Advocate comes whom I [*Jesus*] will send you from the Father, he will testify to me [*Jesus*]."


