Feast of Corpus Christi:

The Eucharist is such an Extraordinary Gift and an Amazing Grace. In The Most Holy Eucharist, we are not only in The Presence of the Almighty God, but our God gives Himself to us. We receive The One Who Created us; The One, Who is ever Present in All of His Infinite Power of Love, gives Himself to us in The Holy Eucharist. This is a Divine Food which nourishes our soul; It is The Holy Medicine of God that heals and strengthens our wounded and broken human nature in so many untold and yet unimagined ways in this broken and disordered world of sin. What a Glorious Blessing to receive our God.

This is The Precious Gift of God that strengthens our soul to continue to have Faith, to Hope, to Love in order to repent and to forgive. The Holy Catholic Church is The Mystical Body of Christ, and The Voice of God that tells us we are being Divinized! Divinized does not mean that we become God; It means that we can become The Full Image and Likeness of God that God created each of us to be, IF!!! we are willing to repent and believe. And If, we are willing, then we will cooperate with our God's Saving Grace through obedience to His Commands by repenting of our weaknesses, inabilities and resistance to be like our Creator. Our Lord Jesus not only lifts us up from our misery and restores us to the glorious heights from which human nature had fallen at The Original Sin, but also, through The Grace of God in The Sacraments, Jesus takes us far beyond The Original Perfection given to Adam and Eve, as God Creates His Life of Love within each of us if we have The Faith, The Hope and The Love to believe such an Amazing Grace that will make us into a new creation.

In the Catechism, paragraph #1375 **"It is by the conversion of the bread and wine into Christ's body and blood that Christ becomes present in this sacrament."** As the simple elements of bread and wine become Glorified into The Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, fully united with The Godhead, so are we to be Converted; Consecrated; Transformed, Transfigured and Glorified into The Image and Likeness of God. This Conversion of souls happens in the most profound and wondrous ways through faithful reception of The Most Holy Sacraments. Our Living and True God does not leave us as orphans, but His Loving Hands hold and caress our weak, broken and impoverished souls. It is through The Power of His Divine Life of Love that New Life enters into the souls of those who will repent and believe. Love is The Most Incredible Power, and there is no Power like it because God is Love. Pray that you may receive all of the Spiritual Gifts, but most of all Pray for Love. When we receive our Lord Jesus Christ, then there is a Power of His Holy Life of Love that transforms even the most difficult and painful situations for us into joy and peace. Even a Crucifixion. When we do things in God's Life of Love, then we are no longer concerned with our selves but only with the Beauty and Sweetness of God's Holy Love, as we willingly and cheerfully go about our tasks as best we can with the Grace that we have been given.

Always pray for the increase in your Baptismal Graces of Faith, Hope and Love, especially Love, so that you may have the eyes to see and the ears to hear how God is trying to save you, and then be able to respond to others with God's Love. Our Baptismal Graces will help you to see how God is trying to feed you, heal you and strengthen you through the Most Holy Sacraments so that you can be Created into a True Image and Likeness of our Lord Jesus Christ in this world.

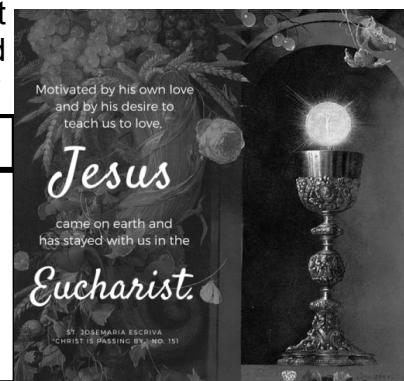

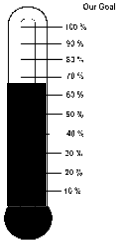

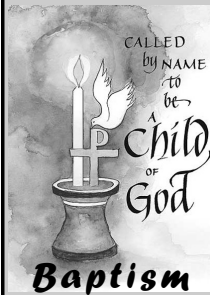
