Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima (part 11)

The first picture depicts the way that The Virgin Mary appeared to the children of Fatima on a cloud on top of the small holm oak tree.

The second picture is of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, which reproduces the vision of the Virgin Mary, Mother of God, in the way that she appeared to the three children of Fatima. The only thing that is not true to the original vision is the location of Her Immaculate Heart surrounded by thorns and aflame with the Fire of God's Love. In the original vision, The Virgin Mary was holding her Immaculate Heart filled with God's Love in her left hand, but the statue makers could not construct a statue durable enough to keep the Heart from eventually breaking off in the hand. So the statue makers repositioned the location of her Immaculate Heart to her chest where it could be solidly connected to the statue. Fr. Doug Binsfeld
