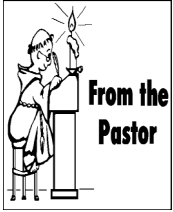

## Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima (part 12)

### The Seven Fatima Prayers:

During the course of the apparitions at Fatima, the three child seers were taught five unique and powerful prayers, two by the Angel of Peace and three by the Mother of God. Later, appearing to Sister Lucy at Rianjo, Spain, Our Lord Jesus Christ dictated two further prayers. For millions of people, these prayers are today a living embodiment of the Message of hope and peace which Our Lady gave the world at Fatima.

The following prayers are prayed in any order which you find most comforting and appropriate.

### The Two Prayers Taught by the Angel:

**Pardon Prayer of Fatima** – “My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee. I ask pardon for all those who do not believe in Thee, do not adore Thee, do not hope in Thee, do not love Thee.”

**Angel of Fatima Prayer** - “Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Ghost, I adore Thee profoundly, and I offer Thee the Most Precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the same Son Jesus Christ, present in the Tabernacles of the world, in reparation for all the sacrileges, outrages and indifferences by which He Himself is offended. And by the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart, and through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.”



### The Three Prayers Taught by Our Lady:

**Eucharistic Prayer** – “O Most Holy Trinity, I adore Thee; my God, my God, I love Thee in the Most Blessed Sacrament.”

**Rosary Decade Prayer** – “O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need.”

**Sacrifice Prayer** – “O my Jesus, it is for love of Thee, for the conversion of sinners and in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer this sacrifice to Thee.”

### The Two Prayers Taught by Our Lord Jesus:

**Prayer to the Immaculate Heart** - “Sweet Heart of Mary, be the salvation of Russia, Spain, Portugal, Europe and the whole world.”

**Prayer to the Immaculate Conception** – “By Thy pure and Immaculate Conception, O Mary, obtain for me the conversion of Russia, Spain, Portugal, Europe and the whole world.”
