Dear Parishioners,

What is the difference between hot dogs and wieners? Last week, we had our 150th anniversary celebration with Mass at our Calvary Catholic Cemetery & Chapel Mausoleum, and I joked about funeral lunches. 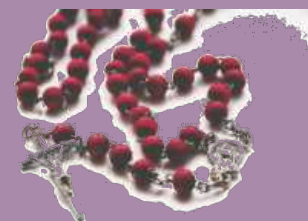
