

Dear Parishioners,

What is the difference between hot dogs and wieners? I went to the expert this week (my mother), and she said, "Wieners are usually made with real skins, not plastic, and have real meat in them, not just scraps and filler." Last week, we had our 150th anniversary celebration with Mass at our Calvary Catholic Cemetery & Chapel Mausoleum, and I joked about funeral lunches. Mass was followed by a lunch of wieners (served not in buns), potato salad, and more. Thanks to all those who helped to put this great event together: Jerry & Michelle (our cemetery staff), Ruthann, Deacon Mark (for the liturgy), the funeral choir, and our cemetery committee. 


A big thank you to our team for their fantastic fundraising this year as we ranked #2 out of 23 teams.
