Begin preparation at least nine months in advance. Call the office to register for the marriage preparation program. Date can be set only after preparation has begun.

I shared about this in a previous bulletin, and wanted to make sure everyone would prepare themselves to bring items to the parish garage sale. I encourage you to bring items to the ACC before May 12. The doors will be open for items to be delivered on May 9th and 10th, from 9:00 to 2:00, or by appointment from April 29th to May 9th. Please call Dena at 508-0885 if you have items to bring for the sale. This is a great time to clean house and support the building fund. We also need people to provide baked goods to be sold on those two days. Helpers are also needed for the sale on the 11th and 12th of May, and to price items on May 9th and 10th. You may not have resources to give directly to the matching grant but you may be able to give some of your time to make this a successful sale.

The old appliances from the kitchen will be made available for the sale, along with desks, file cabinets and tables that are no longer needed in the remodeled space in the Annunciation Parish Center. If you have larger items to be sold, do not hesitate to add to the larger items that are already available. Smaller desks will be used in the office spaces so many of the desks presently used by staff members will no longer be needed. All items not sold at the sale will be donated to Catholic Charities, which will benefit that cause. Watch for the sale to be advertised in the bulletin and in the local newspaper. Again, please donate to this cause and take the opportunity to assist in any way you can during the time of the sale. Thanks for all you do for the parish.

Our hosting duties for Family Promise of the Northland have been put on hold. The program is restructuring and looking for a new director. Thank you to all volunteers!

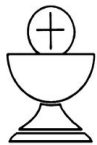
