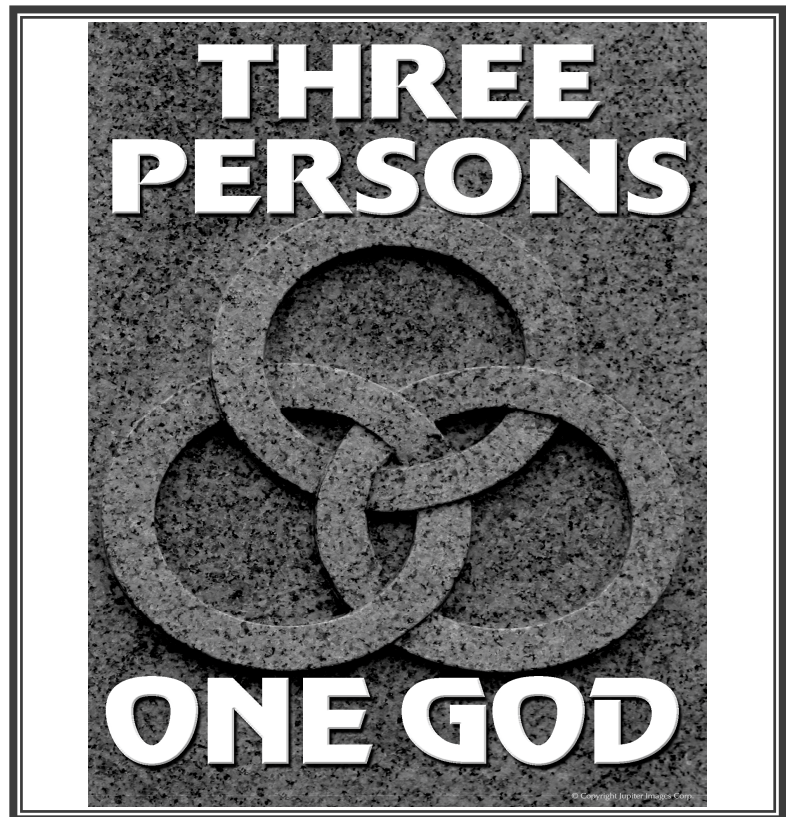

This is just a small reminder that this parish is growing and we will make the effort to keep up with the growth and the needs. 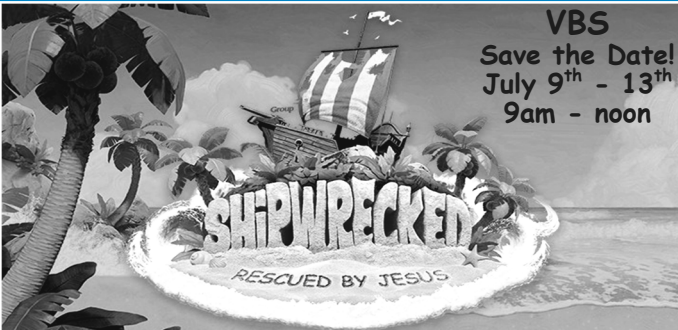
