I encourage all of us to remember in prayer our youth who will be on a mission trip this coming week. They will be heading to Arkansas to get involved in ministry. This is a great opportunity for the young people of our parish to have first hand experiences serving those who are in need. Thanks to the young people participating and to the parents who are giving them the opportunity to be involved in these ministries. As a parish we certainly value this experience, which will impact these young people throughout their lives. Our prayers go with them on their journey.

I also want to share that the Missionaries of the Precious Blood will be having their annual Assembly on June 11 - 13, at the Airport Hilton. Some of you may remember hosting this Assembly for a number of years here at the ACC. The topic for the Assembly will be a discussion regarding the reforming of the community. Because of the diminishing membership, the two provinces in the United States are looking at the possibility of becoming one province in the States. It is interesting that the U.S. Province was divided into three provinces in 1965 because of the growth of membership. Times have changed in the Church since 1965 for both religious and diocesan groups. As most of us know, there are fewer people entering formation programs, and many priests are now at retirement age. This is not a discussion any community or diocese wants to have, but the Missionaries of the Precious Blood are going to have the initial discussion regarding changes in our two provinces. There were three provinces, however, the Western province was not able to continue for financial reasons, along with diminishment in numbers and were absorbed into the Eastern and Midwest provinces a few years ago. There will not be daily Mass from June 11 - 14. Please pray for the Missionaries of the Precious Blood as we approach the gathering and during the Assembly June 11 - 13.

You can register by stopping by the office or by getting a form from Father Al or Ellen Schmitz after Mass.

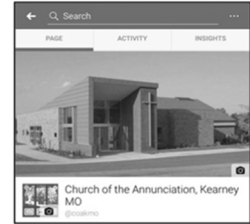
Ellen will have a registration table open after all Masses on June 16/17 & 23/24.
