## Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

After participating with service projects this last week in the parish by those who became part of our church this past Easter through the sacraments, and by our youth who are on a mission trip this week, it reaffirmed my understanding of service needing to be part of our parish life. I appreciated those who were part of the RCIA process this past year, along with some of the sponsors, who as a group wanted to do a service for the parish. It not only impressed me, but it also challenged me. It was not the fact that the parking lot in the church needed striping, but it was something they could do together and serve the people of the parish community. Now this may have been a small service project compared to service with which others get involved, however, it reminded me what can get accomplished when people work together. This group definitely have a sense of parish that may be different from those of us who have been Catholic for years.

I also had the opportunity to spend a couple of days with our young people in Fayetteville, Arkansas on their mission trip. This invites our young people to learn about faith and about service and ministry. This is an experience that hopefully invites them to be connected with Church, both in their local area and globally, in a way they may not have experienced before. What impressed me more than anything was where they were housed for the week. This Church named Grace, an appropriated name, in Fayetteville, opened their building to our young people to use for the week. How great is that! This church which is not Catholic, opened its doors to a group that is Catholic. What impressed me more than that was a chalk board that listed all their ministry sights. Lay people seemed to be responsible for these ministries, and lay people were participating in missions going to Honduras, Thailand, Asia, Croatia, Mexico, and other places. I realize this faith community is more mission oriented in nature, but it got my attention as a life-long Catholic, who grew up in a tradition that does not share about mission very often - that supposedly is for religious communities that have mission work as their charisms or apostolates.

I share these two activities in part because mission and service have always appealed to me, and also because this has not been part of our Catholic tradition and should be. Like the group who were part of RCIA took it upon themselves to be of service, many lay people should maybe step up on their own to be mission and not have it be solely through the invitation and coordination of staff members. Just some thoughts I had driving back by myself from Fayetteville.

- 2.) Contact your local laws enforcement agency or call 911, and
- 3.) After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Jenifer Valenti, at 816.812.2500 or [JeniferValenti@att.net](mailto:JeniferValenti@att.net), if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
