

I was so impressed that he even was interested in coming to Mass while traveling through on vacation, and also impressed with his suggestion about posting a simple sign near the church with the Mass schedule. After having a nice conversation with him I realized that I have encouraged people to attend Mass while traveling and yet our church does not invite people very well. Yes, it is easy for people to get on the computer, but his age group is not necessarily computer savvy and actually it is *his* generation that actually goes to Mass while on vacation. We as a parish could make it a little more convenient to find our Mass schedule. So, what did I learn from this experience? The answer is rather simple. It would be helpful to have a sign near our front door with the Mass schedule to make it more convenient for people. Actually, I have asked that similar question regarding a sign near the front door and someone told me the times were on the large sign by the road. Interestingly, I had not noticed the times were posted on the sign until I was informed. So, I just took that as being an answer until today when the question resurfaced. Again, it is all about being as inviting as we possibly can be. Who knows how many people come by when someone is not in the office? Just another suggestion for us to be a hospitable faith-community.
