

New Parishioners

Begin preparation at least nine months in advance. Call the office to register for the marriage preparation program. Date can be set only after preparation has begun.

Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

Activities seem to slow down in most parishes during the summer months; Mass attendance is down and many programs tend to be put on hold: Many people take vacations, go to the lakes, or have seemingly endless sport activities or camps. In the midst of the lull, however, I was impressed with the number of children who registered for Vacation Bible School and with all those who assisted in the program. There were eighty or more children who participated at VBS, and about twenty-five adults and youth from the parish who helped with the registrations, snacks and facilitating groups. That is commendable! Thanks to the youth who volunteered their time to assist in the program every morning this past week. Thanks to Ellen for organizing and facilitating the process and thanks to Matt Mabrey for motivating everyone during the daily sessions. This is such a good opportunity for our children to be connected to faith and church, so thank you to so many parents who invited their children to participate. I think VBS is always a good alternative to all the other activities offered during the summer months.

Along with the activities that slow down in the parish, there is also a slow down in parish stewardship. That has happened in every parish I have ever served, so it does not surprise me. I, however, want to thank the people who stepped up with donations needed for the air conditioner that needed replacement in the church. Some people were surprised to hear that the cost of the unit was around \$17,000. Yes that is an expensive unit, however, it is a large roof unit and a crane had to be brought in to remove the old unit and replace the new one. Those are always unexpected expenses in a parish, but I am so grateful to those who have made donations to replace the unit. The finance council is aware that there will be miscellaneous expenses and budget for that, but it is great when the generosity of parishioners help to keep line items in the budget as low as possible.

An activity that has also been ongoing is the second phase of the building project. The remodeling of the lower level has been such a blessing and hopefully everyone continues to honor their commitments toward the second phase. The building project has also slowed down in the summer but it definitely has not stopped. I again encourage everyone to stay true to their pledges and those who have not pledged think seriously about making a pledge to the next phase. More information will come available in the next month and the building committee will again be assembled to meet with the architect for further planning.

Thanks to all who have been so generous to this project.


