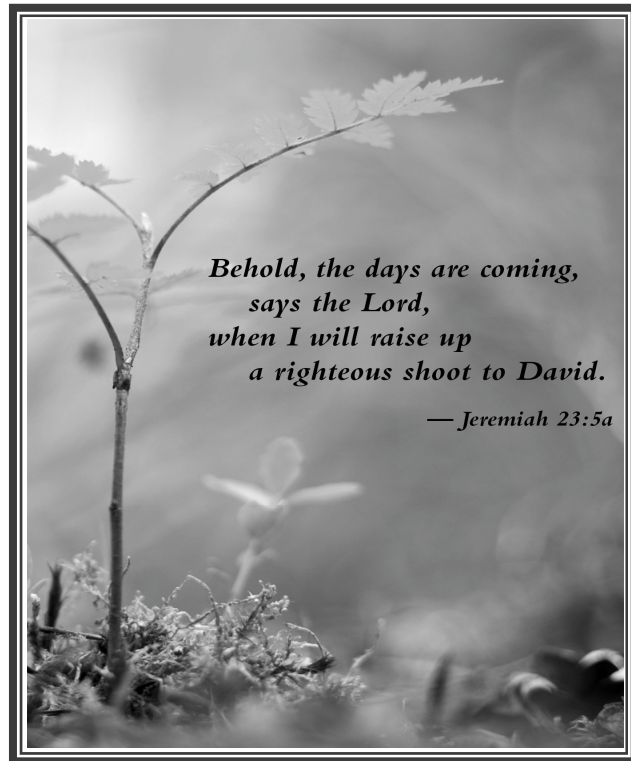

Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

Next weekend, as mentioned in another article in the bulletin, Fr. David Cottingham, CSSp. (Congregation of the Holy Spirit) will be at Annunciation to share about the Spiritan missions and invite us to participate in supporting these missions, both financially and spiritually. This parish had always been very responsive in supporting guest missionaries, so I encourage all of us to support the Spiritan missionaries. Since Fr. David will have the weekend Masses and preach, I will take the opportunity to be away from my office for a couple of days. I am going to Sugar Grove, IL to preside at a wedding of a former Precious Blood volunteer. I will leave Thursday, July 26, and return Tuesday evening, August 30. There will be no morning Masses on Friday, July 27, and on Tuesday, July 31. Hopefully this will not inconvenience anyone.

On an entirely unrelated subject, a couple of weekends ago the parish had the privilege of hosting a youth group from Owatonna, MN, who also joined us at the 8:00 Mass on Sunday, on their way to get involved in mission work in Wichita, KS. I mention this because they reminded me how blessed we are to have our church and hall, and are open to hosting groups. I thought about their comments and wondered how we could market our hall better. I know I have shared in past bulletins that many improvements have been made with new windows, painting, flooring, etc., and Dena has certainly advertised in local papers and on social media. Other venues seem to be chosen over ours even though our rental agreements seem to be less expensive. I just want it to be cost effective for the parish. It has been helpful to have reduced rental costs for active parishioners, but we also need to make sure that all the improvements that need to be made are covered with the income generated from all our revenue. I also have to remember that the hall is periodically used for parish needs such as PSR, fish fries, Knights of Columbus, and many other activities. Just putting this out there for people to ponder and inviting everyone to be part of this discussion.
