

## Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

This past week the parish finance council (Sheila Erzen, Megan Herndon, Brenda Hoover, Gary Warfield, Jared Wolters) met to finalize and sign the proposed budget, which the diocese requires to be presented to them annually. I want to thank Megan, who manages the financial books for the parish and the finance council for their work in assisting with the management of the parish finances. The council members are very qualified to keep the parish finances in check. I normally do not comment on the finances of the parish but since it is fresh on my mind, after discussing the budgeting of the parish income and expenditures I want to share my thoughts. My first observation is that the income for the parish is down slightly, which normally is the case when fundraising is in place. One wishes that people would not cut on their weekly stewardship shifting it to the capital campaign, however, that is the nature of the beast. I want to ease some peoples' concern that parish funding may be shifted from the parish to the building fund, which is not the case. I also want to assure people that there is a financial surplus in the bank for the parish to take care of any expenses the parish may incur.

Parishioners will be receiving an accounting of the basic finances of the parish, which the diocese requires for all parishes. Parishioners have the right to see the books at any time regarding basic income and expenditures. When reviewing the status of the finances presented to the parish, there are certain expenditures people may question. This year the expenditures may seem to be higher than usual. They are greater this year because of deserved raises given to staff members, unexpected maintenance issues, and diocesan requirements. This past year efforts were made to try to update and maintain a few things in and around the ACC. New interior and exterior lighting was installed, and broken windows were replaced and all of them were sealed due to reoccurring leaking. Eventually new carpeting will be installed, which has not been done in a long time, if at all. And of course the \$17,000 air-conditioning in the church, which definitely was unexpected. Those are a few examples of expenses which quickly changes the budget. On top of it all the diocese is also assessing each parish to assist with the diocesan Catholic schools. Every parish has to deal with those expenditures that seem to be out of one's control. The real blessing is that our parish is debt free, which not many parishes can claim. The Church of the Annunciation is truly blessed with generous people, who are willing to sacrifice in so many ways in support of their parish. At this point the parish is doing very well financially, thanks to the stewardship efforts of so many of you.
