Wondrous Love

Dear Sacred Hearts Parishioners:

“Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!”

As Jesus was preparing to “go up to Jerusalem,” He was making not only a physical but also a spiritual and sacrificial ascent. This ascent would bring Him into the Temple and to the earthly limit of Calvary’s summit. On that Good Friday, Mount Everest would shrink before the height of Calvary!

On the road to Jerusalem, James and John demanded that Jesus “do for them whatever they asked of Him.” Our Lord replied, “WHAT DO YOU WANT ME TO DO FOR YOU? (MK 10:36).” James and John, in a bold display of carpe diem, demanded a share in future glory and power. Our Lord assured them they would share in the cup of which He would drink, and undergo the baptism with which he would be baptized, but heavenly glory would have no share with individualism. As Jesus was leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus, the blind beggar, was sitting by the side of the road in the dust. By contrast Bartimaeus cried out, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” Again Jesus would ask, ‘WHAT DO YOU WANT ME TO DO FOR YOU?’ Bartimaeus asked to receive his sight. In his physical blindness Bartimaeus had the spiritual insight to identify Jesus as the Son of David. The physical healing enabled Bartimaeus to “follow Jesus on the Way.” The identification of Jesus as the Son of David spread to the consciousness of the growing crowd. The King of Glory was in their midst! Beyond Bartimaeus’ cry, the requisition of the donkey and the spreading of palms were kingly prerogatives and also served to identify Jesus with Davidic and Messianic promises.

At the very end of that day, Jesus entered the Temple, looked about, and departed for Bethany with the Twelve. Returning from Bethany the following day, our Lord was hungry, but found only a fig tree which was out of season. He cleansed the Temple, and assured His disciples that whatever they asked of God, in faith and prayer, it would be received.

On this Palm Sunday, we have the opportunity to ask Jesus to hear our prayerful and faithful requests. Jesus asks us, ‘WHAT DO YOU WANT ME TO DO FOR YOU?’ Pope Benedict remarked that Jesus comes to us, again and again, not on a donkey, but under the poverty of bread and wine made into His Body and Blood. On this Palm Sunday let us renew our faith and devotion to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The King of Glory is in our midst, in this very Church!

I invite our parishioners and visitors to not only take blessed palms home, but also take a Cardinal’s CATHOLIC APPEAL envelope, found at the ends of the pews. So far, only 75 of last year’s donors have made a contribution. Sacred Hearts Parish is “Parish 249” for Appeal recording purposes. Your generous contribution will help us attain our assessment, but also enable the Cardinal and Archdiocese meet its charitable obligations in Boston and around the world.

Please see the Holy Week schedule in this bulletin. Like Bartimaeus, we need to leave our place, to rise up boldly, and follow Jesus during these holy days. Blessed is the one who enters here in the name of the Lord! The King of Glory is in our midst.

The staff of Sacred Hearts wishes you a happy and blessed Palm Sunday as you visit your families and loved ones’ graves.


