

Dear Sacred Hearts Parishioners:

The sacred liturgy has guided us through the events of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. From Palm Sunday to perhaps an Easter sunrise service, Jesus has revealed the depths of God's love for each of us, and indeed, all of creation. The disobedience of Adam and Eve no longer alienates us from the love of God nor our true homeland, which is Heaven. Jesus is the New Adam. All of us have been given an "open door invitation" to Heaven! The great flood of Noah and crossing the flood waters of the Red Sea find their completion in Jesus Christ, who is the New Moses. Mary, His mother, and ours, stands at our side as we unite our suffering, disappointments and trials to those of her Son! She will stand by our crosses as well. The forgiveness poured forth for us is seen in Divine Mercy. Let us always confidently approach the Lord for his mercy and forgiveness. The darkness of the Easter Vigil reminds us that Christ is the true Light that has come into the world. We are called to be sons and daughters of this Light and New Way of Life. Baptism is a dying and a rising. We are not clothed with burial bands, but we have clothed ourselves in Christ and we have "died to the world."

Having been brought up in an Italian family, the round of visits to relatives always began with the salutation, "Buona Pasqua." Then the feast followed; house by house! Refusing a treat from a loving grandparent, aunt, or uncle would fly in the face of hospitality and the very spirit of Easter! Though we cannot eat an Easter feast every day, nor do we say "Buona Pasqua" every day, we are called to be an Easter people, a Resurrected people every day of our lives. This is the feast of faith Christ calls us to. Let us frequently partake of the Eucharist as Jesus' brothers and sisters, sons and daughters of God, in the great family we have been baptized into. Happy Easter!
