Dear Sacred Hearts Parishioners:

This weekend, the Vietnamese Community, through a generous donor, presented two statues to Sacred Hearts Church. Both statues were hand-made in Vietnam, arriving here just after the Third Sunday of Easter. One is a statue of Pope Saint John Paul II. This statue is entirely hand painted and is made of fiberglass. The other is of Saint Andrew Dũng Lạc. The statue of Saint Andrew is hand carved and made from a solid piece of Vietnamese hard wood, most likely teak. It is harder than oak and seems to be as dense as stone! The statue of Saint Andrew was blessed by Fr. Joseph Cảnh at the 3PM Mass this past weekend. Saint Andrew is currently on display in the Immaculate Heart Chapel (Lower Church) near the statue of Saint Anthony and the image of Divine Mercy.

St. Andrew was born in 1795 in the village of Bắc-Ninh and named Trần An Dũng. His parents were poor. During a 3 year period he received his early Catholic education from a catechist, being baptized in 1810 in the village of Vĩnh-Trị. He took the name “Andrew.” Saint Andrew learned Latin and Chinese which were considered to be classical and scholarly languages required for priestly candidates at that time and place. He was ordained on 15 March 1823. St. Andrew was assigned as a parish priest in Kẻ Dằm. He worked with the Paris Foreign Mission Society, whose efforts inspired St. Therese of Lisieux! His priesthood was marked by zealous preaching, fasting, and persecution. In 1835 St. Andrew was imprisoned under an edict issued by Emperor Minh Mạng (1820-40). Emperor Minh Mạng’s persecution of the Catholics is often compared to the persecution of Christians under Emperor Nero. Some commentators have stated that Minh Mạng’s persecution far exceeded Nero’s in terms of cruelty, brutality and scope. Father Andrew Dũng’s parishioners ransomed him from prison, at which time he changed his name to Andrew Lạc, to avoid recapture. His freedom was short-lived. He was re-arrested on 10 November 1839 while going to confession to Father Peter Thi. Both were be-headed on 21 December 1839. St. Andrew was beatified on 27 May 1900 by Pope Leo XIII. There were four “rounds” of beatifications of the Vietnamese martyrs that spanned many papacies. All martyrs were canonized on 19 June 1988 by Pope Saint John Paul II. Good hagiographical sources on St. Andrew can be found by visiting an Irish Jesuit website sacredspace.ie and in the book *Saints of the Roman Calendar* by Enzo Lodi.

Sacred Hearts is looking forward to First Holy Communion and Confirmation. These joyous sacramental celebrations are important milestones in the “way” of Catholic Initiation. Candidates from the both religious education programs (English & Vietnamese speaking) will have their names inscribed in the parish registers. Our Vietnamese and English Directors of Religious education, John Gia Nguyen and Mary DeAngelo, will soon be joined by a Spanish language religious education director(s). Summer here will be busy.

I am pleased to announce that Deacon Franklin Mejia will assume full time duties at Sacred Hearts Parish. This is in addition to his responsibilities at the Boston Catholic Television Network. Deacon Mejia will work in parish administration, ministry, and of course, liturgy.

I hear the “dinner bell.” Time for macaroni and meatballs! God Bless You!

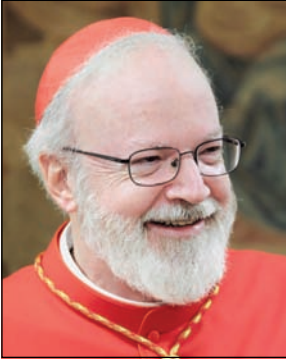
