This past Wednesday evening, Sacred Hearts Parish witnessed the Holy Spirit pour forth his Sevenfold gifts upon our Confirmation candidates. As the Feast of Pentecost approaches, the timing of this celebration could not be more appropriate! Very Rev. Gerard Petringa, the North Region Vicar, was the celebrant. I warmly and cordially encourage these high school students to share their heaven sent gifts, in service, to the Church. Each of them accepts and rightfully exercises a ministry that flows from their Faith, youth, and schooling. Through our religious education directors, an invitation will be extended to them to be involved as lectors, musicians, extraordinary Eucharistic ministers and leaders in youth ministry.

Summer is bringing another round of maintenance projects at Sacred Hearts. Currently the rectory is being repointed, where absolutely necessary. Like the Cheverus, the rectory cornices and parapet needed attention. Unlike the Cheverus, the rectory repair was timely! The entire church will receive up-to-date lighting fixtures with the assistance of Mass Save. The lighting in the lower church is especially in need of such an upgrade. "Let there be light!" New lighting will make a worn out floor look only more worn out! In many places tiles are missing or broken. As part of the project, the brown rug in the nave will be replaced. Additionally, the wall in the lower church that suffered water damage will be restored by a professional church plasterer. Hopefully this will be accomplished before the summer heat sets in!

Next week Deacon Franklin Mejia will begin full time ministry at Sacred Hearts. Until this time, Deacon Mejia assisted largely in the evenings and on Sunday. Deacons, ordained in the title of charity, exercise their role in areas of parish administration and ministry. Sacred Hearts can look forward to in-house events (ministry training, prayer, socials, retreats, education, evangelization, discipleship, and even pilgrimages & travel). Deacon Mejia will be particularly interested in working with our recently Confirmed high school students and also with young engaged and married couples.

It is good to know that much more than repair work will be happening this summer!

Please continue to support the parish weekly collection. These new efforts deserve our financial support & involvement. If there is any way you can increase your weekly contribution, it will help the Parish grow and place it on a better financial footing.


