


Dr. Lukens, Professor of Religious Studies for over 40 years at St. Norbert College in De Pere, was president of the International Bonhoeffer Society from 2000-05, a member of its board of directors from 1915 to 2007, and has lectured on Bonhoeffer widely in the U.S., Germany, and Colombia. Lukens' program is sponsored by Winchester Academy, a Waupaca non-profit organization that fosters lifelong
