"Take this Scapular. Whosoever dies wearing it shall not suffer eternal fire. It shall be a sign of salvation, a protection in danger and pledge of peace."



#### Catechists Are Needed:

As the summer is winding down and the back-to-school displays are prevalent throughout the stores, St. James and St. Mary Parishes are gearing up for the 2017-2018 CCD year. Your assistance is needed in the planning. We have a need for volunteers to complete the teaching staff at both St. James and St. Mary.

As of this time, at St. James is in need of a catechist for  $5^{th}$  grade and  $6^{th}$  grade. The Chosen program and Decision Point is used in our high school classes. There needs to be a minimum of 3 catechists for each grade to facilitate the break out groups. The freshmen ( $9^{th}$  grade) is in need of 3 catechists and the sophomores (grade 10) 1 more catechist. Also a female instructor is needed for Theology of the Body.

As of this time St. Mary is in need of a catechist for 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades (possibly 2<sup>nd</sup> grade also). The Chosen program and Decision Point is used in our high school classes. There needs to be a minimum of 3 catechists for each grade to facilitate the break out groups. Three catechists are needed for 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 1 (possibly 2) for 10<sup>th</sup> grade, and 1 (possibly 2) for 11<sup>th</sup> grade. Also one male and female instructor are needed for Theology of the Body.

We need parents as catechists to ensure that your child is on the path for Confirmation. Many thanks go out to those parents that stepped up last year to ensure that their child was on schedule for Confirmation.

There are flyers in St. James gathering space and at St. Mary in the back of the church. Please look it over.
