HIS WORD TODAY

“He sent two of His disciples and said to them: ‘Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, ‘The Teacher says, ‘Where is My guest room where I may eat the Passover with My disciples.’...’Make the preparations for us there.’”

On this solemn feast, on which we as Catholics are reminded of the special and real Presence of Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist, Mark helps us set the scene. Those close to the Lord are sent to make sure all is ready. One man will lead them to another, whose task it was to have the site ready to receive Christ and celebrate the last supper.

I am one of the two called to make preparation to receive the Lord again in my life. I am reminded how special it is. The Eucharist is a gift, the center of our faith. Like the centurion, I repeat the words ‘Lord I am not worthy...’ but I should add, ‘make me worthy of so great a gift. Help me to devoutly prepare well for the reception of Your gift for me. Make my faith strong to say I believe in Your presence in this sacrament, and welcome to my heart.’

Like the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, I also say “Stay with us, for it is almost evening...” And He does!

FIESTA DE CORPUS CRISTI

Como cada año, Jesús se dispone a celebrar la gran fiesta judía de la Pascua con: sus seguidores y discípulos, aquellos que habían contemplado todos los signos preparatorios para lo que habría de venir: su sacrificio definitivo en la cruz.

Ésta sería la última que celebraría con ellos hasta el encuentro definitivo y personal en el Reino de Dios que tanto había proclamado el Maestro. Su final estaba cerca y quería hacerles uno de los regalos más preciados que conservamos hasta nuestros días: la Eucaristía, la gran acción de gracias.

Había realizado grandes signos y prodigios en medio del pueblo; sus palabras eran distintas al resto de los rabinos, puesto que hablaba con autoridad; enfermos y paráliticos salían curados del encuentro con su persona.

Sentados a la mesa, Jesús toma un poco de pan y se lo ofrece a sus amigos; era la Pascua actualizada y revivida por aquellos discípulos. Jesús se quedaba para siempre en el pan y en el vino.

Pan partido para comer y vino ofrecido para beber; aquella comida que compartieron con Jesús debería recordarse, actualizarse cada vez que se reunieran en su nombre; así sabrían también que el Reino de los cielos es ese banquete ansiado que preside el mismo Jesús.

También nosotros nos sentamos a la mesa con Jesús y nos alimentamos de su propio cuerpo y sangre; la celebración del Corpus hoy es la de la Iglesia que se siente agradecida por tan hermoso don. La Iglesia vive de la Eucaristía y la Eucaristía construye la Iglesia; necesitamos revivir y ser conscientes de lo que verdaderamente significa este banquete en el que Jesús es sacerdote, víctima y altar; comida compartida que crea en nosotros vínculos de unidad y fraternidad; alimento eterno que nos fortalece y nos anticipa el Reino de Dios..
