

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

All you who are thirsty come to the water! You who have no money, come, receive grain and eat; come, without paying and without cost, drink wine and milk! Why spend your money for what is not bread; your wages for what fails to satisfy? Heed me, and you shall eat well, you shall delight in rich fare. What we are hearing is God's divine invitation to us. The question is: Do we recognize that? Does it mean anything to us, or are we just not interested?

In the first reading Prophet Isaiah utters words of consolation to the people in exile. He invites them to put God first in their lives and by so doing they will enjoy countless advantages. He will fill them with new things and make a banquet for the suffering people. In the second reading Paul assures us that because of God's love for us, we can conquer every hostile power. With God on our side no one can be against us, since God's love takes care of us. We are consoled that God is our support and strength. In the Gospel, Jesus miraculously feeds five-thousand people in the desert with five loaves and two fish. He shows his concern towards people who had left everything and stayed with him. This miracle is seen as a foreshadowing of the Eucharistic meal which Christ is going to provide for his followers.

Last week you may have noticed the new style of the bulletin. I received many positive comments about the change in style and am grateful for those that gave their input. We are also in the process of updating our website.
