DO YOU KNOW THE SAINTS AND THE SEASONS?

June 2—St. Marcellinus and St. Peter, Martyrs. In 304, a Roman priest and an exorcist, named respectively Marcellinus and Peter, were apprehended and thrown into prison. They strengthened others of the faithful and made new converts.

June 3— St. Charles Lwanga, martyr and his companions, martyrs. Over one hundred killed in this period, including Anglicans. Charles is the patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action.

June 5—St. Boniface, bishop and martyr. Founded abbey of Fulda; bishop of Mainz; martyred along with thirty companions at Dokkum in Frisia; known as the “Apostle of Germany.”
